Terms and Conditions, Assumption of Risk, Release of Liability & Media Consent



For the purposes of these Terms and Conditions, "Company" means Athlogix, Inc., a Colorado corporation doing business as Beast Hockey Global, together with its owners, officers, directors, employees, contractors, coaches, volunteers, representatives, affiliates, and agents. All disclaimers, limitations of liability, releases, and indemnification obligations contained herein apply equally to each of these parties.

I acknowledge and understand that participation in the Beast Hockey Global event involves inherent risks, including, but not limited to, risks associated with ice hockey games and practices, tournament play, transportation, international travel, sightseeing, excursions, recreational activities, sporting venues, hotels, restaurants, and other on- and off-ice activities. These risks include, without limitation, the possibility of serious personal injury, illness, disability, death, property damage, theft, or loss.

I voluntarily assume all risks associated with my participation, and the participation of any accompanying family members or guests for whom I am responsible, whether such risks arise before, during, or after the event.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, I hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue the Company from any and all claims, demands, causes of action, damages, liabilities, costs, or expenses arising out of or relating to my participation in the event, including claims for personal injury, illness, death, property damage, theft, or loss of personal belongings, whether occurring during hockey activities, transportation, international travel, accommodations, excursions, or any other event-related activity.

I further acknowledge that the Company is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property during the event.

I grant the Company the irrevocable right to photograph, film, record, and otherwise capture my name, image, likeness, voice, and participation during the event and to use such materials, without compensation or further approval, for promotional, advertising, marketing, educational, and other lawful business purposes in any media now known or later developed.

- No refunds or credits will be issued to participants who begin but do not complete the event, except as specifically provided under the Payment Protection Plan (PPP) for qualifying injuries or illnesses supported by appropriate medical documentation.
- If the Company cancels the event for any reason, refunds and/or credits will be administered in accordance with the Payment Protection Plan (PPP) provisions described above.

- Unless the Payment Protection Plan (PPP) has been purchased, Beast Hockey Global is not responsible for providing refunds, credits, or reimbursement for cancellations or interruptions resulting from circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to severe weather, natural disasters, airline disruptions, government travel advisories, public health emergencies, epidemics, pandemics, labor strikes, facility closures, transportation interruptions, or other force majeure events.
- All cancellation requests must be submitted using the official Cancellation Request Form, available upon request. The effective cancellation date will be the date the completed form is received by Beast Hockey Global.

Any participant removed from the event will be responsible for all additional travel and accommodation expenses incurred as a result of their removal.
